

Cobb County-Marietta Water Authority

WYCKOFF RAW WATER PIPELINE IMPROVEMENTS (30-INCH REPLACEMENT)

PROJECT LIMITS:

The project is approximately 1.5 miles in length and will be conducted in public right-of-way and in existing and new Cobb County-Marietta Water Authority easements beginning on the north side of Lake Allatoona and ending near the intersection of Highway 293 and Cedar Street.

PROJECT SCOPE:

The Wyckoff Raw Water Pipeline Improvements project involves replacing an aged, undersized section of a water line that supplies raw water to the Hugh A. Wyckoff Water Treatment Plant. The existing 30-inch prestressed concrete cylinder pipe (installed in 1964) will be replaced with a 54-inch ductile iron pipe. This new water line will improve water supply redundancy and reduce the potential for pipeline failures. The project will involve removing the existing pipe from the ground and installing the new pipe in its place.



TENTATIVE SCHEDULE

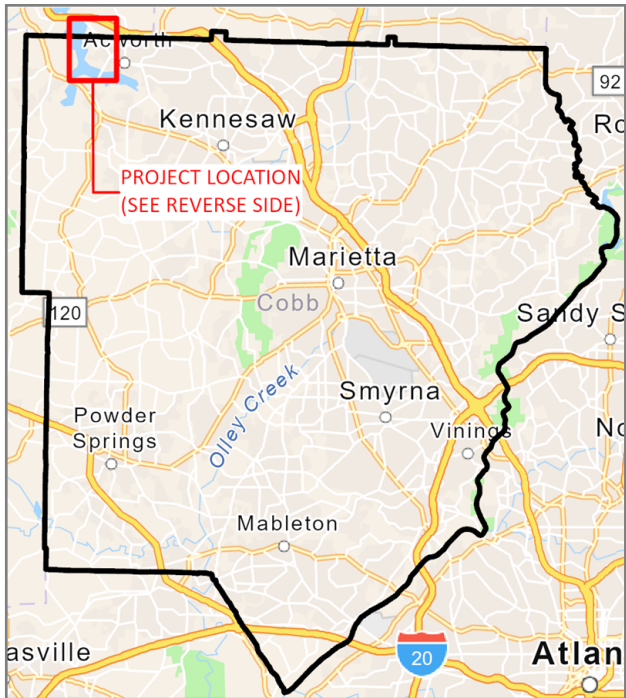
- Complete Design Plans: June 2021
- Complete Easement Acquisition: Mar 2022
- Construction Begins: January 2022
- Construction Complete: March 2023

BENEFITS TO THE COMMUNITY

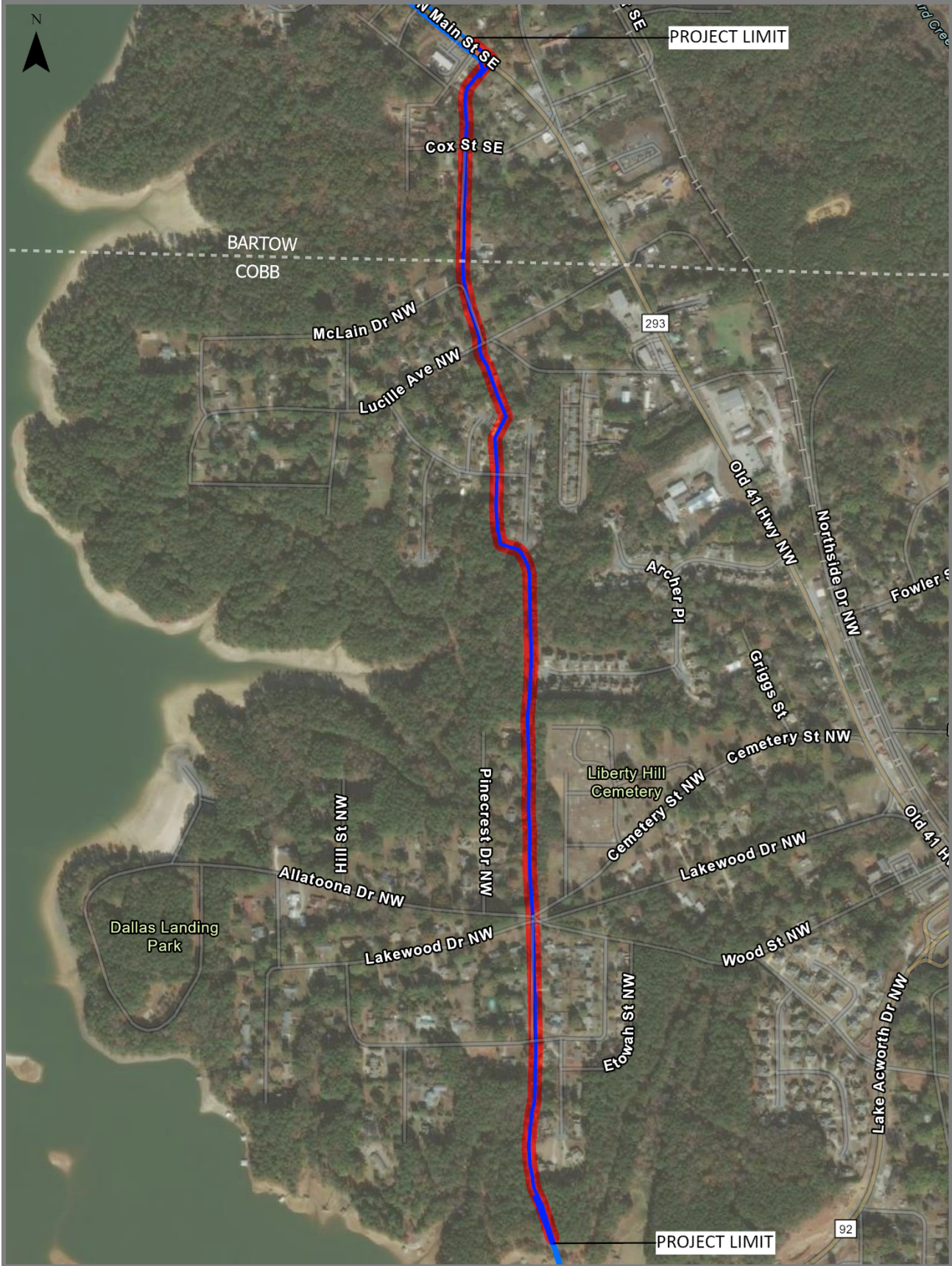
- Replaces 50+ year old pipe
