The Board approved the minutes of the December 17, 2018 Regular Meeting.

The Board approved the minutes of the December 17, 2018 Executive Session.

The Board following the recommendation of the Finance Committee approved the modification of Note 1 to the Procurement Policy to read as follows:

Item #2 - Proposed change does not exceed \$50,000.

General Manager and Authority Chair may approve: Item #2 – Proposed change does not exceed \$100,000.

The Board approved the award of the Highway 41 Northwest 20-Inch Parallel Pipeline Project to Reynolds Construction, LLC of Fairburn, GA for the verified low bid of \$4,945,031.71.

The Board approved the award of the Wyckoff Wash Water Tank Painting to Precise Contractors, Inc. of Moultrie, GA for the verified low-bid price of \$241,982.50

The Board approved a new five-year Intergovernmental Agreement with Macon Water Authority for Land Application of Residuals by Macon Soils Inc., with rates to be adjusted annually according to the Consumer Price Index.

The Board approved a five-year contract for Professional Agronomist Services with Branch Residuals and Soils, LLC of Greensboro, North Carolina, with maximum annual total of fees of \$110,000
